The petitioner was declared proclaimed offender. However, it is submitted that he and his co-accused were witnesses in a murder case against complainant – Gurcharan Singh and others. Out of the persons who were accused in the present case, Fauja Singh was the complainant in the murder trial against the present complainant, and the petitioner and other accused were the witnesses.

Also, State counsel has informed that the complainant and one eye-witness have already been examined by the trial Court.

Therefore, at this stage, there does not appear to be any possibility for the petitioner to tamper with the evidence or to make any effort to win the witnesses over. He shall be allowed to bail to the satisfaction of concerned Trial Judge/Duty Magistrate.
