PARAMJEET SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petitions have been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in the case FIR No.108 dated 06.11.2014, under Section 399/402 of Indian Penal Code and 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that charges have been framed and the petitioners are behind bars since 06.11.2014. Learned State counsel states that prosecution has not led any evidence till today and it may take sufficient long time.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future the petitioners can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petitions are allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate Moga.
