Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in pursuance of order dated 04.05.2015 passed by this Court in CRM-M-7410-2015, the petitioner has joined the proceedings and instant petition qua challenge to order dated 20.03.2007 declaring the petitioner proclaimed offender has become infructuous.
