MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 249 dated 02.11.2014 under Sections 452, 336, 324, 323, 427, 148, 149 (Sections 307/325 added lateron) IPC and 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Beas District Amritsar Rural.

According to the allegations in FIR, the petitioner along with a number of other persons attacked the complainant in his house and one of the accused persons also fired a shot in the air. As far as the petitioner is concerned, he has been attributed a 'datar' blow on the left elbow of Lakhwinder Kaur. It is stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that he is in custody since November 2014 and the trial will take some time to conclude. He further contends that one of the accused persons who has fired a shot, though in the air, has been granted concession of bail.

Be that as it may, noticing the fact that the petitioner is in custody since November 2014 and the trial which is in progress may take some time, I would, without commenting upon the merits of the case, deem it appropriate to accept the petition and grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, instant petition is allowed. It is directed that the petitioner be released on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C. Bail to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
