The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect/safeguard the life of the petitioners at the instance of respondents No.4 to 8.

On instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh, learned State counsel submits that so far respondents Nos 2 and 3 have not received any request for protection from the petitioners.

Considering the submissions made on behalf of the petitioners, it is ordered that as and when petitioner No.2 has to appear in the Court for recording of her statement, she will be at liberty to approach respondents No.2 and 3 for providing protection to her.

Respondents No.2 and 3 shall dispose of the application, so given by petitioner No.2.

In the above terms, the present petition stands disposed of.
