Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Parshotam Singh, Police Station, Beas, District Amritsar, submits that petitioner No.1 (Mandeep Pal Singh @ Mani) and petitioner No.3 (Awarjit Singh @ Bau) are proclaimed offenders and they are not entitled for filing the instant petition.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action but with better particulars, as and when necessity arises.

Permission is granted.
