Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.479 dated 17.9.2012 under Sections 323, 427, 341, 393, 394, 506, 120-B IPC read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Bhiwani Sadar, District Bhiwani (Annexure P-1) along with all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 20.2.2015 (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 4.3.2015 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court to get their statements recorded in support of their compromise.

Accordingly, the parties have appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bhiwani and have got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has forwarded his report dated 10.4.2015 to the effect that the compromise entered between the parties is genuine and the same has been effected voluntarily without any force and pressure.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 (P&H) and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and others**, (2012)10 SCC 303, this petition is allowed and FIR No.479 dated 17.9.2012 under Sections 323, 427, 341, 393, 394, 506, 120-B IPC read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Bhiwani Sadar, District Bhiwani (Annexure P-1) along with all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed on the basis of compromise dated 20.2.2015 (Annexure P-2).
