Report dated 2.6.2015 sent by the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Mohali has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Jasvir Singh, Darbara Singh, Gurmukh Singh, Kuldeep Kaur, Daljit Singh, Kirandeep Kaur as well as of complainants Amarjeet Singh, Paramjeet Kaur and Surinder Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties are immediate neighbours and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.46 dated 3.6.2010 under Sections 452,323,325,148,149 IPC Police Station,

Sohana, District Mohali and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
