Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Satya Pal Yadav, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rewari, District Rewari on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed in Court today and same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

2. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 81, dated 06.05.2013, under Sections 323, 325, 354-D and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 25.02.2015 (Annexure P-3).

3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that genuine compromise has been entered into between the aforesaid parties voluntarily, without any coercion or undue influence. No other case is pending against either of the parties. Even otherwise, matter involved in these proceedings is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

4. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in case reported as Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another; 2012(4) RCR(Criminal) 543, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

5. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 81, dated 06.05.2013, under Sections 323, 325, 354-D and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari and all proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed qua petitioner.
