**JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 119 dated 07.04.2013 under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal on the basis of compromise along-with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Siddharth Dhanda, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hathin. The same is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have compromised

the dispute voluntarily, without any pressure, coercion or inducement. The same is genuine one. Even otherwise, matter involved in these proceedings is matrimonial in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in case reported as **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another; 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 119 dated 07.04.2013 under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed qua the petitioners.
