INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for protection of his life and liberty or in the alternative, for issuance of direction to official respondents to consider the representation dated 25.08.2013.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has confined his prayer only for the relief that his representation dated 25.08.2013 (Annexure P-7), given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, Respondent No.3 is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-7) and to take appropriate action as per law and pass appropriate order within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order. However, it is made clear that the SSP, Mohali will not be influenced from this order and he shall consider the representation strictly as per law. Further, no gunman be provided to the petitioner in routine manner. If the SSP, Mohali feels that there is serious threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, only then he shall take steps to provide gunman to the petitioner.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
