MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 14 dated 20.1.2015 registered under Sections 380, 506, 341, 457, 34 IPC at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot.

It was contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the dispute is essentially between her husband and the complainant regarding possession of the property which was purchased by her father in law. It was further contended that petitioner alongwith her husband is staying in portion of the property and on account of this dispute false allegations are being levelled.

Noticing the aforesaid facts, this Court had granted interim protection dated 4.3.2015 pursuant to which the petitioner has since joined the investigating to the satisfaction of the Investigation Officer which fact is not controverted by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI

Harpreet Singh.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case but noticing the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer, instant petition is accepted. Interim directions dated 4.3.2015 are hereby made absolute, however subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
