Heard.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in a case registered against him in December 2010. The petitioner was released on bail but thereafter absented and was declared a proclaimed offender on 27.03.2014. He was arrested on 17.01.2015.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was a victim of circumstances and could not put in appearance because he had no knowledge of the date fixed in the case and had no intention to avoid the process of the Court.

A perusal of the record shows that the case was registered in 2010, charge was framed in July 2011. The petitioner absented on 26.02.2013 and repeated notices and warrants of arrest could not be executed and the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender. The petitioner could only be arrested in January, 2015. No case for bail is made out. The petitioner has misused the concession of bail that was allowed to him. The petition is dismissed.
