Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., seek quashing of FIR No.152 dated 14.12.2010 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 325, 452, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion was issued. Parties were directed to appear before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar on 30.03.2015 for getting their statements recorded.

When the parties did not appear before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate on 30.03.2015, learned counsel for the petitioners sought yet another opportunity which was granted by this Court, vide order dated 20.04.2015. However, neither order dated 09.03.2015 passed by this Court has been complied with so far, as the parties did not appear before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar nor anybody has come present to press this petition.

In view of the above, it prima facie, seems that petitioners are not interested in pursuing this petition.

Having left with no other option, the present petition is disposed of, with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action, as and when necessity arises.

Disposed of, accordingly.
