Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, namely, Jaswinder Kaur wife of Budh Singh in case FIR No.30 dated 11.2.2015 under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

This Court vide order dated 12.3.2015 had granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to her joining investigation and complying the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that husband of the petitioner who is co-accused in the case has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM No.M-6236 of 2015. He further

states that pursuant to order dated 12.3.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Madan Mohan, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 12.3.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
