SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.57 dated 10.03.2014, under Sections 302/450/216/120-B read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the name of the petitioner had not figured in the FIR. She has been falsely involved in the instant case on the supplementary statement made by co-accused Suresh. No role has been attributed to the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 5.9.2014. Co-accused Bimla wife of Om Parkash has already been enlarged on bail by this Court vide order dated 26.2.2015.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the prayer of the petitioner and submits that there are specific allegations against the petitioner that she alongwith other co-accused hatched a

conspiracy to commit the murder of deceased Vinod.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

The petitioner is stated to have no relation with the main accused namely Deepak Gahlawat, Devender and Rohtash. Co-accused Bimla has already been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 26.2.2015 passed in CRM-M-5761-2015. The petitioner is in custody since 05.09.2014.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of regular bail.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is admitted to bail, and she be released on his furnishing bail/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.
