The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 99 dated 20.09.2011 registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri under Sections 148, 149, 452, 307, 302, 506, 216, 120-B IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that Anil Kumar and Vinod, co-accused in this FIR with similar allegations have been granted bail and the petitioner is seeking parity. Referring to the FIR he states that Anil Kumar and Vinod were also accused of firing in the air and similar allegations were made against the petitioner and the petitioner was not challaned and was subsequently summoned and he is in custody since 24.07.2014 and the trial is not proceeding.

A case was registered against 22 persons. 6 persons were found innocent and were not challaned. No injury is attributed to the petitioner. The petitioner was summoned on the application

under Section 319 Cr.P.C. and he is in custody since July 2014. The co-accused with similar allegations were allowed bail. The petitioner is entitled to bail on the ground of parity.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that trial is taking time, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
