This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing Criminal Complaint No. 300/1 dated 20.05.2009, under Sections 323, 458, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

In compliance with the order dated 04.03.2014, report from learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, has been received in which it is mentioned that parties have arrived at a compromise.

Learned counsel for the parties have also stated at bar that the matter has been compromised.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as, "*Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others*" **2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the above said complaint stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant thereto also stand quashed.
