Allowed as prayed for.

Main case

The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 383 dated 26.5.2012 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 34 IPC at Police Station, Civil Line Karnal, Haryana.

The petitioner alongwith few others have been named in a dubious land transaction whereby causing loss to the complainant of a substantial amount.

Notice was issued in this case and an application bearing CRM no.11624 of 2015 has been filed placing on record a settlement between the parties. It is thus contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that

since the matter has been resolved amicably between the parties and the dispute essentially being monetary in character arising from a sale transaction, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody any further.

The fact of the compromise is not disputed by the learned counsel for the complainant.

On due consideration of the matter and noticing the fact that the parties have settled the matter amicably, instant petition is accepted. It is directed that the petitioner be released on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C . Bail to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
