The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to official respondents No. 1 to 3 to take adequate measures to ensure the protection of the life and liberty as also property of the petitioner by contending that he faces threat to the same at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9. Further direction sought is to the official respondents to take action against private respondents in the light of the statutory provisions contained under the Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.

Without even going into the merits of the controversy as also without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the petition at the initial stage itself in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No. 2 i.e. The Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar as regards his grievance. Upon any such representation/claim petition being filed, respondent No. 2 would be obligated to consider the same, verify the contents thereof and thereafter to take such steps as deemed fit and warranted strictly in accordance with law.

Petition disposed of.
