JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The petitioners seeks regular bail in case FIR No.263 dated 01.07.2014, registered under Sections 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act, at P.S. Bahadurgarh, Distt. Jhajjar.

The learned counsel for the petitioners refers to the statement of Yudhvir Singh, PW-1, the injured complainant, and states that the petitioners have not caused any injury to the complainant. He further refers to the statements of PW-2, Jagbir Singh, the father of the complainant, and PW-3, Ashok Kumar, injured/brother of the complainant, who have not supported the case of the prosecution. One

of the petitioners is a serving jawan of the Indian Army who had come to avail the yearly leave and has been falsely implicated. The petitioners are in custody since 03.07.2014 and 27.07.2014, respectively. They are not involved in any other case.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that out of the total twenty prosecution witnesses, four have been examined.

Heard.

The parties are residing in the immediate vicinity of each other. The four prosecution witnesses including the complainant have not supported the case of the prosecution. Only four, out of twenty prosecution witnesses, have been examined so far, thus, the trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future.

In the circumstances, without advertng to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioners be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, subject to their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
