Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Ramesh Pal, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, DLF, Gurgaon on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

2. Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 412, dated 25.10.2013, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sushant Lok, Gurgaon (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

3. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have got recorded their statement voluntarily and without any fear coercion or pressure. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

4. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

5. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 412, dated 25.10.2013, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sushant Lok, Gurgaon and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioners.
