Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case criminal complaint No.26/1 dated 15.06.1998, titled 'Darshan Singh vs. Amandeep Kaur and others' filed by respondent No.2 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and later on charged under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 04.05.2015, this Court granted liberty to the

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petitioner to appear before the trial Court and on doing so, he was ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of order dated 04.05.2015, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail.
