Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioners/accused-Yatin Katyal and Mini Katyal in case bearing FIR No.41 dated 14.02.2015, under Sections 406, 498-A, IPC registered with Police Station Ambala Cantt., District Ambala.

The petitioners are brother-in-law and sister-in-law of the complainant-Meenakshi Katyal, the author of the aforementioned FIR.

It is submitted that the allegations qua the petitioners are vague and they have nothing to do with the matrimonial life of the complainant and her husband-Ruchin Katyal. The petitioners further have been shown to be residing separately at Muradabad (U.P.).

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Amar Singh, states that pursuant to the interim order dated 04.03.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 04.03.2015 is made absolute.
