The petitioner is in custody since 18.04.2013

Six out of the twelve prosecution witnesses have been examined. Practically half of the trial only has been concluded. Also, it is pointed out by counsel for the petitioner that in the FIR, it was mentioned that the police had met one Lucky Kapla son of Shri Ram Kishore and in his presence the petitioner was found in possession of 30 plastic bottles of Rexcof Cough Syrup, whereas said witness appeared in Court as PW3 and totally denied that he was ever present with the police party, as alleged.

Copy of statement of the said witness is placed on record as Annexure P-1.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing given above to be taken as an expression on the merits of the case.
