MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner had earlier filed a petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise which he chose to withdraw. Now he wishes to press the issue on merits by pleading that there was a settlement inter se between the parties.

In the considered view of this Court this is merely a jugglery of words and a ploy to file the second petition which on the face of it is not maintainable. Once the petition has been withdrawn on the basis of compromise, second petition seeking quashing on merits again on the basis of settlement would not be maintainable especially when the settlement alleged is the same with no new facts intervening.

Dismissed.
