MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for his release on bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case registered vide FIR No.74 dated 23.11.2014 under Sections 452, 382, 323, 324, 427, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Tibbar, District Gurdaspur.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner though named in the FIR and armed with a Dattar has not been attributed any role in causing injuries to the victim and in similar circumstances pre-arrest bail to co-accused, namely Daljinder Singh alias Ladhu was granted.

This Court on 11.3.2015 had granted the interim protection to the petitioner, pursuant to which he has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer which

fact is not disputed by the learned counsel appearing for the State of Punjab on instructions from ASI Vijay Pal.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions dated 11.3.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
