This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar, vide FIR No.84 dated 28.06.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner himself surrendered before the investigating agency. Challan against co-accused has already been filed before the competent court of jurisdiction. Petitioner, thus, deserves to be enlarged on bail during the proceedings.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer. According to her, petitioner is the main accused in the case. She, however, agrees that investigation of the case is almost complete.

Keeping in view facts and circumstances of the case, period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner and the fact that the trial may take long time to conclude, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose
