JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.7 dated 26.01.2011 under Sections 419, 465, 467, 468 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Baretta, District Mansa, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR.

Report of the trial Court has been received in which it is mentioned that parties have arrived at a compromise. The matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably settled.

In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.7 dated 26.01.2011 under Sections 419, 465, 467, 468 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Baretta, District Mansa, and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
