Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising out of FIR No. 917, dated 09.12.2014, under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Jind City, District Jind.

Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh submits that out of total 11 prosecution witnesses cited, 10 have already been examined and only one witness remains to be examined.

Since the case is at the fag end, this Court does not close deem it fit case to grant bail. Therefore, the present petition is dismissed.

However, trial Court is directed to decide the case preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
