NAVITA SINGH, J.

Initially, the case was registered under Section 302 and other offences of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act. However, later on, Section 304 was substituted with Section 302 IPC. The petitioner was named in the FIR. He was named by co-accused Ashok Kumar, who allegedly confessed about a fire shot from his gun by him and in his disclosure statement/confession, he mentioned the name of the petitioner further stating that the petitioner was having a 12 bore revolver.

Charge-sheet has been filed in the Court and the charges have been drawn up, as stated by counsel for the petitioner, but no evidence has yet commenced.

The trial is likely to take time to conclude. Disclosure statement of co-accused Ashok Kumar at this stage cannot be stated to be sufficient proof regarding involvement of the petitioner in the incident.

In view of the above, the petitioner is allowed to bail to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur.
