Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.30 dated 21.02.2013 under Sections 21, 22, 61, 85 & 27-A of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act ('NDPS Act' for short), registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no recovery was effected from the petitioner and he is in jail for the last more than one year and 11 months. He further submits that since the prosecution evidence is going on and the trial will take long time, in these circumstances, petitioner deserves concession of bail pending trial.

Notice of motion was issued and in response thereto, learned counsel for the State submits the petitioner has been found involved in as many as 10 more FIRs. A mobile phone was also recovered from the petitioner in jail. She prays for dismissal of the petition.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties at considerable

length and keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, no case for bail is made out, at this stage. It is so said because petitioner has been found involved in as many as 10 criminal cases under the NDPS Act.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed, at this stage.
