- i. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for regular bail filed in case bearing FIR No.44 dated 04.03.2013, under Sections 306/354 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel has argued that one co-accused had filed CRM-M No. 26600 of 2014 and when that came up for hearing on 13.08.2014 it was argued that he had been in custody for 1 year and 4 months but on behalf of the State it was represented that only three witnesses remained to be examined and they would be summoned for the next date. Consequently this court dismissed the petition but directed the trial Court to release that petitioner on bail in case all the witnesses were not

examined. As a matter of fact all the witnesses were not examined and that co-accused was granted bail on 22.09.2014. Even till date one witness remains to be examined and, therefore, the petitioner should also be granted bail. Learned Addl.AG has argued that the matter is now fixed for 06.02.2015 and the sole witness, who remains to be examined, would be examined on that date.

In these circumstances the present petition is also dismissed but the trial Court is directed to release the petitioner on bail in case the entire evidence of the prosecution is not led on 06.02.2015 subject to the petitioner not obstructing the same.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
