The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.120, dated 20.09.2014, registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 34, 326 of the IPC, at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar.

Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw this petition. He further prays that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court on 22.1.2015 and a direction be issued to the trial Court to decide the application for regular bail within two days.

Allowed as prayed for. Dismissed as withdrawn. In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on or before 22.1.2015 and

moves an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided by the trial Court, in accordance with law, within two days of its filing. Till 22.1.2015, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed. In case the petitioner defaults, this petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.
