The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for the issuance of directions to the official respondents no.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner by pleading that he faces apprehension to the same at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 8.

Without even going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent no.2 i.e. the S.S.P., Ropar as regards any apprehension and grievance that he is entertaining. Respondent no.2 in turn would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take all such steps as he may deem fit in accordance with law.
