FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 6.4.2015 sent by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Gurinder Singh and Sahejbir Singh as well as of complainant Nirmal Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that by way of compromise deed Mark-A the parties have compromised the matter and the offences are not heinous in nature and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.143 dated 06.05.2014 under Sections 353,186,323,506,34 IPC Police Station, City Tarn Taran and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
