JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.169 dated 08.05.2014, registered under Sections 302, 364-A, 201, 34, 120-B, 216 of the Indian Penal Code, (for short, 'the IPC') and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City, Dadri, Distt. Bhiwani.

The learned counsel, inter alia, contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. He has been implicated on the disclosure statement of co-accused, Lalit Kumar. Two co-accused, Amit and

Sarita, have been found innocent by the police. The petitioner is in custody since 08.05.2014. The trial is yet to commence.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is one of the conspirators. The challan stands presented. Out of 33 prosecution witnesses, none has been examined so far.

Heard.

This is the second bail petition preferred by the petitioner. The earlier petition bearing CRM-M-33471-2014, was dismissed as withdrawn on 06.10.2014. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that during the interregnum period, two co-accused, namely Amit and Sarita, have been found innocent. However, in the considered opinion of this Court, no benefit of the same can be given to the petitioner. The offence allegedly committed by the accused is comes under the category of heinous crime. The complainant is yet to be examined. In case, the petitioner is allowed bail, there is every possibility that he may influence the course of trial. Therefore, no case for grant of relief sought is made out.

Dismissed.
