Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.156, dated 22.04.2014 under Sections 419 and 420, IPC, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Gurgaon, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 10.03.2015, petitioner has joined the investigation .

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Anil Kumar does not dispute the aforesaid fact and further states that further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, order dated 10.03.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

The petitioner shall continue to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. during investigation.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.

It is made clear that nothing observed herein shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the learned trial court shall consider the case on the basis of evidence and material as produced before it.
