Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.77 dated 19.6.2013 registered under Sections 324, 323, 341, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 307/325 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Lambi, District Muktsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 12.3.2015 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for the purpose of investigation, because he has already been put in column No.2 by the investigating agency.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Malkiat Singh, Police Station Lambi, submits that it is a matter of record that petitioner was put in column No.2 but a red entry was made, pointing out that proclaimed offender proceedings were going on against the petitioner.

Be that as it may, since the petitioner has been put in column No.2 by the investigating agency itself, he deserves the concession of anticipatory bail. In this view of the matter, the order dated 12.3.2015 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
