This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.402 dated 24.05.2014 (Annexure P-1), registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Karnal Civil Lines, District Karnal, Haryana .

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

The FIR was got registered on the statement of Deputy General Manager of Oriental Bank of Commerce,

Regional Office, Karnal, with the allegations that Ram Krishan son of Ram Sarup has obtained a house loan of Rs.8 lacs against security of an immovable property by preparing false documents.

The name of the present petitioner does not even figure in the FIR. He was thereafter arrayed on the basis of a disclosure statement made by Ram Krishan to the effect that the petitioner had participated and played a role in preparing false and forged documents relating to immovable property on the basis of which the loan has been sanctioned.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ranbeer Singh, would apprise the Court that the investigation in this case is still under way and otherwise also, the present petitioner is not involved in any other criminal proceedings. The petitioner has been in custody since 10.02.2015.

Without making any observations on merits, the present petition is allowed.

Bail to the satisfaction of the CJM Karnal.
