The petitioner is in custody since 20.08.2014. Recovery of 210 tablets of Alprazolam (21 x 10 strips), 200 tablets of Fortadol (20 x 10 strips) and 5 bottles of Rexcof (5 x 100 mls) was not of commercial quantity, as stated by his counsel.

So far only charges have been drawn up and prosecution evidence has yet not commenced. Trial is, therefore, likely not to be concluded very soon.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

Nothing given above to be taken as an expression on the merits of the case.
