The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 329 dated 08.01.2014, under Sections 406 and 498-A, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Vide order dated 11.03.2015, the petitioner was ordered to deposit Rs.25,000/- with the Registry to be paid to the respondent as litigation expenses.

Petitioner has not complied with the order dated 11.03.2015. Otherwise also, there are serious allegations against the petitioner that he has tortured and given beatings to the complainant and he is not even co-operating in the investigation.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner and the petition is, hereby, dismissed.
