The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to official respondents no.1 to 4 to proceed further in the matter in the light of an inquiry report dated 16.5.2011 at Annexure P-1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

Brief facts, as would emerge from the pleadings on record are that a complaint was filed by the present petitioner as regards negligence at the hands of Dr. Parminder Kaur Johal, respondent no.5 and Dr. Harjinder Singh Sidhu, respondent no.6 while dealing with the delivery case of his daughter-in-law namely Amandeep Kaur and which finally had resulted in the unfortunate incident of a still born child on 28.4.2011.

Apparently, acting on the complaint lodged by the present petitioner, the Deputy Commissioner, Moga had constituted a Committee consisting of S.D.M., Dy.S.P., City Moga and C.M.O, Moga to go into the allegations of medical negligence at the hands of the afore-noticed two doctors. The report dated 16.5.2011 of such Committee has been placed on record at Annexure P-1. The conclusion and findings recorded by the

Committee point towards the negligence of the doctors concerned which led to the delivery of a still born child.

The petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present petition being aggrieved of the inaction of the official respondents in not having proceeded further in the matter inspite of the report having been submitted by the duly constituted Committee.

Without making any comments and observations on merits, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Moga, respondent no.3 to look into the matter and to take all such steps as he may deem fit and as would be warranted strictly in accordance with law as a follow-up to the inquiry report dated 16.5.2011 at Annexure P-1 furnished by the duly constituted Committee.

Disposed of.
