Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.163 dated 27.12.2014, registered at Police Station Kalka, District Panchkula, under Sections 304-B and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 24.03.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

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On instructions from ASI Rajpal Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and her custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 24.03.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.
