Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No. 18 dated 7.4.2014, under Sections 363/366/109 IPC, registered at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur.

In compliance of the order dated 26.3.2015, learned counsel for the State has placed before this Court two statements suffered by the prosecutrix, one under Section 164 Cr.P.C. dated 26.7.2014 and another suffered before the learned trial court on 24.4.2015 as PW-3.
