The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.17 dated 13.02.2015, under Sections 498-A, 342, 323 of IPC, registered with Police Station Gurdaspur.

The allegations are that the petitioner (mother-in-law) along with her family members had made a demand of a Safari Car and are also alleged to have given beatings to the complainant-Gurjit Kaur on 29.11.2014.

As per the MLR of the complainant, four injuries found are simple in nature.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner (mother-in-law) had joined the investigation during the interim protection granted, vide order dated 02.03.2015, by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur and, therefore, nothing more is to be required from her.

On the other hand, learned Counsel for the complainant as well as learned State Counsel have opposed the bail application.

In view of the above, interim order dated 02.03.2015, passed by the trial Court, is made absolute.
