Prayer in the present petition filed u/s 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 02, dated 06.01.2015, for offence under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC and 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station, Sadar Abohar, District-Fazilka.

Vide order dated 11.03.2015 passed by this Court, the anticipatory bail application qua petitioner No.1-Aman Singh @ Amandeep Singh has been dismissed as not pressed. However, petitioners No. 2, 3 and 4 were granted interim bail by the same order.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Baljinder Singh, very fairly conceded that in compliance of the order dated 11.03.2015, the petitioners No. 2, 3 and 4 have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order dated 11.03.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, petitioners No. 2, 3 and 4 shall join investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
