ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the P.O. order dated 10.04.2010 and the subsequent proceedings. It was pleaded that vide judgment dated 02.12.2014 the co-accused had been acquitted.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had returned from Australia and had appeared before the Court on 25.03.2015 and had furnished bonds and the case had been adjourned for awaiting supplementary challan. He urges that he is ready to face trial and the P.O. order be quashed.

The petitioner has appeared before the Court and undertook to face trial, the order dated 10.04.2010 declaring him proclaimed offender is set aside. The trial Court has already made suitable order placing restrictions on his visits abroad.

The counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press his petition with respect to the other claims.

In view of the above position, the petition is disposed of. The trial Court would expedite the trial.
