Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.1 dated 07.01.2013, under Sections 324/326/452/34 IPC registered at Police Station Badhni Kalan District Moga, on the basis of compromise. The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Paramjit Singh alleging that petitioners attacked complainant on account of a dispute regarding throwing 'roori' in the street. The petitioners have been attributed injuries with 'daah' and 'soti' blows.

Statement of the parties, pursuant to the order dated 28.05.2015 stand recorded by the Illaqa Magistrate. A report has been received that the matter has been compromised voluntarily, without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

Following the judgment in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to a condition that petitioners will deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within a period of one month.
