Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and have married against the wishes of their family members. They seek protection of life and liberty. They have filed a representation of SSP, Chandigarh,

The case appears to be covered by the judgment of **Pardeep Kumar Singh Vs. State of Haryana**, 2008 (3) RCR (Crl.) 376.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that none of the petitioners would be taken in custody by any of the respondents, forcibly on the allegation that petitioner No.1 has been abducted or raped by petitioner No.2

In case of any imminent threat to the petitioners, it will be open to the petitioners to approach the police authorities for necessary action and implementation of this order.
